The Bonnedame mentioned here was Claude Bonnedame described as the “postmaster of Noyon” in 1686 and as “the messenger of Noyon in Paris” at the February 5th 1687 marriage of Jean de Caisne, son of Anthoine, grain merchant and former alderman of Noyon, to his daughter Marie Bonnedame.^{xxi} As to the mention of Mr. Gosse, it might have been Pierre Gosse, Françoise’s uncle, master tanner, husband of Godeberthe Le Mannier, who would die in 1680 and whom we have previously studied.
