

Last Will and Testament of Thomas Sammon, deceased,

In the Name of God, Amen.

I, Thomas Sammon of the Township of Highland in the County of Guthrie
and State of Iowa, of the age of sixty six years and being of sound mind
and memory, do make, publish, and declare this my last will and testament
in manner following; that is to say:

I give and bequeath to my wife J. Ellis K. Sammon all my real estate now
owned, by me the same being the S 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. No 2, Township No Eighty one
North, of Range No Thirty two, to be hers to be used and enjoyed and to
have absolute contrall of the same during her life, and at her death the above
real estate is to be divided as follows; the S 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec No 2, Township
No Eighty one, North, of Range No Thirty two West of the 5th P.M. to be divided
into three equal parts according to the cash value thereof and to be
divided as follows:

To my son Thomas Jefferson Sammon I will and bequeath one
third of the real estate above mentioned,

To my son Timothy Sammon I will and bequeath one third of
the real estate mentioned herein,

To my son Edward Sammon I will and bequeath one third of
the real estate mentioned herein,

in no case mentioned above,

¶ To my daughter now Mrs Margaret Brook I will and bequeath the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to be her share of my estate the same to be paid to her or her heirs by my sons Thomas, Timothy and Edward, share and share alike before they can enjoy their allotment as mentioned in this will.

¶ To my daughter now Mrs Julia Ann Gouger I will and bequeath the sum of Five Hundred dollars to be her share in full of my estate the same to be paid to her sons Thomas, Timothy and Edward, share and share alike before they can enjoy their allotment as mentioned in this will.

¶ To my son John Sammon, I will and bequeath the sum of one hundred Dollars to be his share in full of my estate the same to be paid by my sons Thomas, Timothy and Edward share and share alike before they can enjoy their allotment as mentioned in this will.

¶ To my son William Sammon I will and bequeath the sum of Five dollars to be his share in full of my estate the same to be paid by my sons as hereinbefore mentioned.

¶ The above mentioned legacies of Eleven hundred and five dollars can be paid to the above mentioned Legatees by my sons within one year after my demise and when so paid they shall be released from the terms of this will.

Lastly. I give and bequeath all the rest residue and remainder

of my personal estate goods and chattels of what nature or kind soever
to my wife Julia R. Sammon, whom I hereby appoint sole executrix
of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills
by me made if any.


